Mr. Lisowski is Orchestra Director at Falls Church High School, where he also teaches the Music Sampler class and is a Tri-M Music Honor Society advisor at FCHS. In 2012 he was nominate for the FCPS Outstanding First Year Teacher of the Year Award. In addition to his teaching duties at FCHS, Mr. Lisowski joined the artistic staff of the Youth Orchestra of Prince William in 2013 as the Primo Conductor.

Mr. Lisowski graduated Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Music Education from Shenandoah Conservatory in Winchester, VA., where he studied with Akemi Takayama and Doris Lederer.

Since 1983, the MYO has offered outstanding playing opportunities for young musicians in Northern Virginia under professional leadership. The MYO and Rep are designed for outstanding students in grades 5 to 12. Both youth groups offer students the opportunity to play in accomplished ensembles that train them for a lifetime relationship with classical music.
